

## **Academic General Internist**

The Department of Medicine, Faculty of Medicine at the University of Toronto and the Division of General Internal Medicine and Geriatrics of the University Health Network (UHN) and Sinai Health System (SHS) is seeking to recruit an Academic General Internist to be based at Toronto Western Hospital. The successful candidate should have strong interest in Ambulatory Care. Additional training in medical informatics, patient safety, quality or medical education will be expected.

Responsibilities will include a combination of clinical care, teaching, and quality improvement with the mix of responsibilities depending on the successful candidate's background and job profile. Clinical responsibilities associated with this position will consist of ambulatory care (75%) and inpatient care (25%); the successful candidate will have an opportunity to build on a well-organized and highly successful ambulatory clinic that has been developed at Toronto Western Hospital. There are numerous opportunities for education, research, and quality improvement associated with this clinic.

Applicants suited for University of Toronto Faculty of Medicine's Clinician Teacher and Clinician in Quality and Innovation academic positions will be particularly considered (see link for academic position description details: <http://www.deptmedicine.utoronto.ca/academic-position-descriptions#AcademicPositionDescriptions>). Competitive candidates will possess outstanding communication, teaching, organizational and interpersonal skills that enable them to work collaboratively with other physicians, learners, hospital staff and administrators.

Applicants must be certified (or eligible for certification) by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and must be licensed (or eligible for licensure) in the Province of Ontario. The successful candidate must hold MD qualifications and advanced methodological training (Master's Degree, Doctoral Degree or equivalent). Academic rank, salary and contractual arrangements will be commensurate with the qualifications and experience of the successful candidate (estimated range \$200-\$250,000 per-year). Compensation will be negotiated and within the usual income range for an academic general internist in the Province of Ontario. Applications will be accepted until February 1, 2018 or until the position is filled.
