Job Description:

Winchester District Memorial Hospital is recruiting for a skillful General Internist (no endoscopy) with a special interest in cardiology to provide service in a community practice as well as providing in-patient care at the hospital. The position also includes consultations to the Emergency Department and in-patients, as well as one in four Hospital On-Call Coverage alongside a dedicated and proficient team of health care professionals. There is currently a large referral base that would lead to a full practice. A Centre of Excellence for Rural Health and Education, WDMH offers and encourages opportunities for teaching of medical students and residents through our affiliation with the University of Ottawa.

WDMH is a 49 bed rural community teaching hospital with approximately 2500 admissions per year. Our total patient volume through WDMH is approximately 90,000 per year, of which 24,000 are Emergency Department, 500 surgical in-patient, 4200 day surgeries, 700 obstetrical deliveries, and 19,000 ambulatory clinic visits. There are approximately 25 full time family doctors working within the hospital setting. Many others also provide community care or work in the Emergency Department and make referrals regularly to specialists practicing at Winchester.

Winchester is a small community in central Eastern Ontario, approximately 30 minutes south of Ottawa and 20 minutes north of the 401. Our catchment area includes Dundas county and parts of the counties of Stormont, East Grenville and South-East Ottawa-Carleton.
