General Internal Medicine Physician University Health Network and Mount Sinai Hospital Department of Medicine, University of Toronto

The Department of Medicine, Faculty of Medicine at the University of Toronto and University Health Network (UHN) and Sinai Health System are seeking to recruit academic General Internists to join the Division of General Internal Medicine and Geriatrics. Faculty should have additional training and clinical interest in Obstetric Medicine to support a dynamic and growing program based at Mount Sinai Hospital. The successful candidate should be eligible for faculty appointment at the rank of Lecturer, Assistant, Associate, or Full Professor at the University of Toronto as well as hospital appointment and CPSO licensure. Effective start date is September 1, 2017, or shortly thereafter.

Responsibilities will include a combination of clinical care, teaching, and quality improvement with the mix of responsibilities depending on candidate background and job profile. Applicants suited for positions in specific University of Toronto job profiles including Clinician in Quality and Innovation and Clinician-Scientist will be particularly considered (See link for job description details: <http://www.deptmedicine.utoronto.ca/academic-position-descriptions#AcademicPositionDescriptions>). Competitive candidates will possess outstanding communication, teaching, organizational and interpersonal skills that enable them to work collaboratively with other physicians, learners, hospital staff and administrators. Candidates should also have an established track record in their areas of interest (clinical care, research, quality improvement) particularly for those seeking appointment at the Assistant Professor-or-higher level.

The successful candidates should be eligible for an academic appointment at the University of Toronto. Rank and Salary per annum will be commensurate with qualifications and experience (estimated range \$200-\$250,000 per-year). Compensation will be negotiated and within the usual income range for an academic general internist in the Province of Ontario.

Applicants should be certified (or eligible for certification) by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and must be licensed (or eligible for licensure) in the Province of Ontario. The successful candidate must hold MD qualifications and advanced methodological training (Master's Degree, Doctoral Degree or equivalent). Academic rank, salary and contractual arrangements will be commensurate with the qualifications and experience of the successful candidate.
