

JOB POSTING GENERAL INTERNAL MEDICINE STURGEON COMMUNITY HOSPITAL

The University of Alberta, Faculty of Medicine & Dentistry, Department of Medicine, Division of General Internal Medicine in partnership with Alberta Health Services invites applications for a General Internal Medicine Consultant to be based at the Sturgeon Community Hospital, St Albert, AB, Canada, the Faculty has been internationally recognized as among the world's top 50 medical schools and as one of Canada's premier health-education institutions. The University is currently home to more than 38,000 students with more than 15,000 faculty and staff.

The General Internal Medicine Division at the Sturgeon Community Hospital consists of two consulting, admitting services and the new recently established triage hospital medical consultation service that may function as an overflow service in cases of excessive inpatient clinical demands along with preoperative and outpatient clinic coverage.

The successful candidate will be an MD (or equivalent) with certification in General Internal Medicine with the Royal College of Physicians & Surgeons of Canada, be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Alberta (CPSA).

Key accountabilities of the Internist will include, but will not be limited to triaging of patients in the Emergency room, admitting patients, looking after inpatients, discharging patients, in hospital consultations, Preop Clinics, and possibly involvement in the development of Alberta Healthcare Services initiatives such as connect care system (provincial clinical information system).

The successful applicant will be expected to apply for a Clinical Academic Colleague Appointment in the Department of Medicine, University of Alberta, which will be considered under a separate process through the Faculty of Medicine & Dentistry.

Remuneration for this position is based on fee for service.

Interested candidates are asked to submit online a letter of intent and curriculum vitae outlining their education, qualifications, experience, research interests, along with three letters of reference. If the selected candidate is interested in application for a position in the development of Connect care, a separate application will need to be done to the corresponding AHS authorities.
