

LOCUM GENERAL INTERNIST

Northern Health is seeking General Internists for locum coverage at various dates in 2018 in Fort St. John, British Columbia. The locum will be compensated through the Rural Specialist Locum Program which provides a daily minimum guaranteed rate of \$1200, plus accommodations and travel within BC.

The locum will be hospital based, and will not be required to do any clinic work. There are currently 3 General Internists serving the Northeast region of BC, with 2 based in Fort St. John and 1 in Dawson Creek. Call is shared. The patient volume in Fort St. John is variable. The typical schedule will include 10-24 hour call days.

Required dates:

- April 30- May 13
- May 28- June 10
- July 23- August 5
- Aug 20- Sep 3

Dates are flexible, and the department can accommodate a locum most times during the summer months.

The new Fort St. John Hospital and Residential Care opened in 2012. The facility has 55 acute care beds and 123 residential care beds and is equipped to handle 22000 emergency visits per year. Facilities include:

- Endoscopy suite
- 2 state of the art operating rooms plus procedure room
- Ambulatory clinics including cancer clinics and hemodialysis
- Medical and surgical inpatient rooms
- Intensive Care Unit

While in Fort St. John you will have the opportunity to take part in a variety of activities, such as:
