Sault Area Hospital (SAH) is a state-of-the-art facility that opened in March 2011. SAH provides emergency, primary, secondary, selected tertiary and long-term care healthcare services to the city and the District of Algoma with a catchment population of approximately 115,000.

The internal medicine program is represented by specialists in respirology, cardiology, oncology, hematology, gastroenterology, nephrology, neurology, endocrinology and a 12 bed closed ICU. SAH has both a Family Medicine Hospitalist program and an Internal Medicine Hospitalist program. There is full support by all surgical specialties, except cardiac & neurosurgery.

General Internal Medicine practice provides an anticipated annual income of approximately 400K and would include coverage of the following (see Appendix A attached for more details):

- General Internal Medicine Unit and high intensity Medical Short Stay Unit
- ED Medical Consult Service
- Medical follow up Care Clinic

Options exist for:

- ICU call or cross-appointment
- Heart failure and medical clinics

- General endocrinology
- Hepatology
- Infectious disease
- Allergy & immunology

Sault Ste. Marie is located on the St. Mary's River between Lake Huron and Lake Superior on the U.S. border.
