

Dr. Mahesh Raju Award for Resident Mentorship 2018

Terms of Reference

The Canadian Society of Internal Medicine (CSIM) is offering an Award to a resident in Atlantic Canada in recognition of their mentorship of junior colleagues. The CSIM is pleased to announce this Award in appreciation of the contributions made by **Dr. Mahesh Raju**. Dr. Raju planned the Atlantic Region Internal Medicine Meeting for many years, is a CSIM past-president, holds a CSIM Osler Award and is a long-time member of the CSIM.

ELIGIBILITY

- Open only to residents in Atlantic Canada.
- Must be a CSIM Resident Associate enrolled in a residency program in Atlantic Canada.
- Be a resident in GIM or resident in their R4 or R5 year as of June 15, 2018. Additionally, R3s who have been accepted into a GIM program are also eligible.
- Consideration will be given to the applicant's work and contributions in fostering collegiality amongst residents, teaching junior learners, and demonstrating leadership in the areas of medical education, research, and/or community outreach.

THE AWARD

- There will be one award consisting of a certificate and a monetary prize of \$500.
- The award will be presented during the CSIM Annual Meeting October 10-13, 2018 in Banff, Alberta.
- The recipient will also receive complimentary registration to attend the CSIM Annual Meeting and a travel grant of up to \$500 to help defray the travel and accommodation costs of attending the meeting in Banff (receipts required).
- The recipient will be invited to join the CSIM Education Committee.

The application package must include the following:

1. A cover letter from the nominator or program director outlining the mentorship qualities exemplified in the nominee.
2. A letter from the program director *only* if he/she is not the nominator.
3. One letter of support from a fellow resident.
4. The applicant's current curriculum vitae.

Please send application documents as separate attachments with consistent file names (i.e.: CV John Smith_NIA 2018.pdf; Support Letter 1 for John Smith_NIA 2018.pdf, etc.)
