## **THE CSIM OSLER AWARDS 2018**

## **Terms of Reference**

Nominations are invited for the Canadian Society of Internal Medicine Osler Awards.

These awards are presented annually to CSIM Full Members demonstrating excellence in achievement in the field of general internal medicine (GIM), either in clinical practice, research, medical education, specialty development or health promotion.

### FLIGIBILITY

Nominees are to exemplify the best in medicine in the tradition of Sir William Osler and be:

- 1. CSIM Full Members in good standing (with dues paid).
- 2. Physicians residing in Canada and licensed to practice medicine in Canada.
- 3. Practicing in community or urban practice.

The nominee must agree to have his/her name put forward.

#### RFVIFW.

Nominations will be reviewed by a CSIM panel and the successful candidate(s) will be announced by CSIM through social media, the website, the newsletter and the *Canadian Journal of General Internal Medicine*.

#### **AWARD**

The Award consists of a plaque, engraved with the name of the individual, attesting to recognition by his/her peers and by the CSIM for achievement in the field of general internal medicine. There will be up to two awards presented annually.

The Award(s) will be presented during the CSIM Annual Meeting at The Banff Centre in Banff, Alberta, from October 10-13, 2018. Recipients who attend the annual meeting to personally accept their award will be provided with one full complimentary meeting registration and will be asked to participate in at least one mentoring session. Other costs to attend the meeting (e.g., travel, hotel) are the responsibility of the recipient(s). Nominations which are not accepted will be carried forward to the following year.

### Nomination package must include the following:

- 1. The candidate's curriculum vitae.
- 2. A letter from the nominator listing the reasons for nomination and emphasizing aspects of accomplishment in his/her field.
- 3. A letter from the seconder contributing a perspective to the nomination.

Please send application documents as separate attachments with consistent file names (e.g.,: "JohnSmith\_Osler\_CV.pdf"; "JohnSmith\_Osler\_NominationLetter1.pdf".)
