

**Lecturer / Assistant Professor – Academic General Internist
University Health Network and Mount Sinai Hospital
Department of Medicine, University of Toronto**

The Department of Medicine, Faculty of Medicine at the University of Toronto and University Health Network (UHN) and Sinai Health System are seeking to recruit an academic General Internist to join the Division of General Internal Medicine and Geriatrics. The successful candidate must be eligible for an academic appointment at the rank of Lecturer or Assistant Professor at the University of Toronto with the academic position description of Clinician Scientist. Effective start date is July 1, 2019, or shortly thereafter.

Responsibilities will include a combination of clinical care, teaching, quality improvement and research. Scholarly interest essential to be eligible for an appointment as a Clinician Scientist. Scholarly excellence will be assessed by the presence of research grants, publications in leading journals, invited presentations at significant conferences, awards, accolades, and other related accomplishments. Specifically, the ideal candidate will have publications in the areas of health policy, health services research, quality and safety, or clinical epidemiology. The successful candidate will be given substantial protected time and mentorship to grow their research career.

The successful candidate must hold an MD degree and advanced methodological training (master's degree, doctoral degree or equivalent) in economics, epidemiology, or a related discipline. Applicants must be certified (or be eligible for certification) by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and must be licensed (or be eligible for licensure) in the Province of Ontario (CPSO).

Academic rank, salary and contractual arrangements will be commensurate with the qualifications and experience of the successful candidate (estimated range \$200-\$250,000 per-year). Compensation will be negotiated and within the usual income range for an academic general internist in the Province of Ontario.
