

## **Assistant Professor – Academic General Internist**

### **University Health Network and Mount Sinai Hospital and University of Toronto**

The Department of Medicine, Temerty Faculty of Medicine at the University of Toronto, Sinai Health System and University Health Network are seeking to recruit an academic General Internist to join the Divisions of General Internal Medicine and Geriatrics. The successful candidate should be eligible for a full-time clinical academic appointment at the rank of Assistant Professor with the position description of Clinician Scientist. Effective start date is July 1, 2022, or shortly thereafter.

Responsibilities will include a combination of clinical care, teaching, and research. In accordance with the Clinician-Scientist position description, excellence will be assessed by an interest and demonstrated excellence in carrying out research, as demonstrated by publications in leading journals, presentations at significant conferences, awards and accolades. The successful candidate should have an advanced degree in economics, epidemiology, pharmacology or a related discipline. A track record of publications in the area of Obstetrical Medicine and/or epidemiology and clinical experience in Obstetrical Medicine is highly desirable to leverage opportunities for collaboration with Sinai Health System's Women's & Infants' Centre of Excellence. Successful candidates will be given substantial protected time and mentorship to grow their research career.

Applicants should be certified (or eligible for certification) by the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada and must be licensed (or eligible for licensure) in the Province of Ontario. The successful candidate must hold MD qualifications and advanced methodological training (Master's Degree, Doctoral Degree or equivalent) or be currently completing their Degree. Academic rank, salary and contractual arrangements will be commensurate with the qualifications and experience of the successful candidate.

Estimated remuneration will be in the range of \$250,000 – 300,000 per annum and commensurate with academic rank, qualifications, and experience. Compensation will be negotiated and within the usual income range for an academic general internist in the Province of Ontario. Applications will be accepted until January 23, 2022, or until the position is filled.
