Yarmouth Regional Hospital (YRH)

The Internal Medicine Group at YRH is recruiting for an additional full-time Internal Medicine physician to join their collegial group of 7. Subspecialties currently include General Internal Medicine, Gastroenterology, Respiriology and Nephrology.

Yarmouth Regional Hospital offers echocardiography, exercise stress testing with nuclear imaging and pharmacologic stress testing, pacemaker follow up, endoscopy (diagnostic and therapeutic gastroscopy and colonoscopy), bronchoscopy, PFTs, Sleep studies, peritoneal dialysis, and hemodialysis (acute and chronic). Diagnostic imaging modalities include Ultrasound, Nuclear Medicine, CT scanning, and MRI. The ICU has its own portable ultrasound machine. There is a Cardiac Rehab Clinic managed by a Nurse and physiotherapist in collaboration with Internal Medicine Physicians.

The Yarmouth Regional Hospital is a community site for the Family Medicine program at Dalhousie University with approximately 5-6 residents per year. In addition, a Internal Medicine fellowship program for R4 and R5 fellows will be starting in July 2019, which will provide us with 2 full time fellows each year.

The successful candidate will be expected to participate in the call schedule for IM, ICU, and Internal Medicine hospitalist, as well as provide outpatient care appropriate to their subspecialty. Call is currently approximately 1 in 7. In addition, you will be expected to participate in teaching both family medicine and internal medicine residents and fellows.

Yarmouth is located at the southwestern most tip of Nova Scotia serving a population of approximately 60,000 in three counties. Affordable housing is available on stunning ocean and lake frontage properties. Yarmouth is the recreational, entertainment and shopping hub of the southwest area. There is so much to enjoy about the SouthWestern end of Nova Scotia, including a unique and storied Acadian French history!

License and Eligibility

Candidates must be a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada or eligible to take the Fellowship Exam in Internal Medicine. Must hold or be eligible for licensure with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Nova Scotia.

Remuneration

Compensation is fee for service with flexible vacation time. In addition, specialists receive call stipends and other incentives as available through the Master Agreement of Nova Scotia.

Incentives
