- Be either Family Medicine (CCFP) or Internal Medicine (FRCPC) trained
- Have acute care hospitalist experience
 - Experience with Hematology inpatients would be an asset
- Have excellent English language communication skills; French is an asset
- Be eligible for an independent license with the College of Physicians and Surgeons of Ontario (CPSO)
- Be registered in good standing with the CMPA
- Be a Canadian Citizen or Permanent Resident



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Work Expectations:

- Requested **minimum of 4 shifts per month** with flexible arrangements available
- Hours of responsibility: 5 pm until 8 am
- On-site requirement as indicated by patient needs, with possibility of home call
- Workload: Nocturnal coverage for approximately 50 inpatients for active medical issues and overnight admissions
