

THE CSIM OSLER AWARDS 2020

Terms of Reference

Nominations are invited for the Canadian Society of Internal Medicine Osler Awards.

This award is presented annually to physicians who demonstrate outstanding achievement in the field of general internal medicine, either in clinical practice, research, medical education, specialty development or health promotion.

Nominees should:

- Exemplify the best in medicine in the tradition of Sir William Osler.
- Have a sustained record of excellence and innovation in the field of general internal medicine.
- Have contributions over their professional career that clearly sets them apart from their peers.

ELIGIBILITY

The nominee must be:

- A physician residing in Canada;
- Currently licensed to practice medicine in Canada, and;
- A CSIM Full Member in good standing (with dues paid) (nominee agrees to have their name put forward).

REVIEW

Nominations will be reviewed by a CSIM panel and the successful candidate(s) will be announced by the CSIM through social media, the website, the CJGIM, at the CSIM Annual Meeting and/or in the member newsletter.

AWARD

The award consists of a plaque, engraved with the name of the individual, attesting to recognition by their peers and by the CSIM for achievement in the field of general internal medicine. There will be up to two awards presented annually.

The award(s) will be presented during the CSIM Annual Meeting October 14-17, 2020 in Quebec City. Recipients who attend the 2020 CSIM Annual Meeting to personally accept their award will be provided with one standard complimentary meeting registration (sessions with extra fees are not included) and will be asked to participate in at least one mentoring session. As well, recipients may be asked to partake in judging resident competitions. Other costs to attend the meeting (e.g., travel, hotel, extra courses) are the responsibility of the recipient(s).

Awards must be accepted in the year they are won and cannot be brought forward to future years.

The nomination package must include the following:

1. The candidate's curriculum vitae.
2. A letter from the nominator listing the reasons for nomination and emphasizing aspects of accomplishment in the candidate's field as outlined in the above criteria.
3. A letter from the seconder contributing a perspective to the nomination.
