

## **Dr. Mahesh Raju Award for Mentorship 2021**

### **Terms of Reference**

The Canadian Society of Internal Medicine (CSIM) is offering up to two awards per year in recognition of mentorship.

The CSIM is pleased to announce these awards in appreciation of the contributions made by **Dr. Mahesh Raju**. Dr. Raju planned the Atlantic Region Internal Medicine Meeting for many years, is a CSIM past president, holds a CSIM Osler Award and is a long-time member and supporter of the Society.

#### **ELIGIBILITY: AWARD ONE**

**One award for a resident in recognition of mentorship of junior resident colleagues.**

- This award is intended for residents pursuing a career in the field of Internal Medicine or General Internal Medicine.
- Open to CSIM Resident Associates (R3, R4 or R5 as of the competition deadline) in a GIM or IM residency program in Atlantic Canada.
- Has **not** previously [been a recipient](#) of a Dr. Mahesh Raju Award for Mentorship. Nominee must agree to have their name put forward.

#### **ELIGIBILITY: AWARD TWO**

**One award for a physician in recognition of mentorship of residents and dedication to internal medicine.**

- Open to physicians practicing in Atlantic Canada.
- Consideration will be given to the applicant's work and contributions in fostering collegiality amongst residents, mentoring trainees, and demonstrating leadership in the areas of medical education, research, and/or community outreach.
- Consideration will be given to the applicant's dedication to IM/GIM in Canada.
- Has **not** previously [been a recipient](#) of a Dr. Mahesh Raju Award for Mentorship. Nominee must agree to have their name put forward.

#### **THE AWARDS**

Each recipient will:

- Receive a certificate of recognition and a monetary prize of \$500.
- Be announced via the CSIM website, social media, e-newsletter, and/or through the [CJGIM](#).
- Be invited to join the CSIM Education Committee.

#### **APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

The application package must include the following:

1. A cover letter from the nominator outlining the mentorship qualities exemplified by the nominee.
2. *For resident nominees:* a letter from the program director **only if they are not** the nominator.
3. One letter of support from a resident colleague.
4. The applicant's current curriculum vitae.
