

GIM RESEARCH-IN-PROGRESS VIRTUAL SEMINAR

Terms of Reference 2021

The GIM Research-in-Progress Seminar will provide two Early Career Investigators or trainees in GIM the opportunity to present an ongoing project and receive feedback from a panel of early career and senior researchers as part of an interactive virtual workshop.

TERMS

- This opportunity is available to CSIM Full Members (in good standing) who are Early Career Investigators, having held full-time faculty appointment in Canada for a period of up to 10 years (cumulative) (e.g. faculty appointment that provides eligibility to apply for grants and/or supervise trainees).
- Trainees in a GIM/IM residency program (PGY4 or higher) may also apply; trainees must be CSIM Resident Associates ([click here](#) to join).
- Eligible research-in-progress projects must be GIM-related.
- Selected authors will have approximately 20 minutes to present their project (virtually via Zoom. This will be followed by a discussion period.
- The session is tentatively scheduled for March 4, 2021, 4:00-5:15pm Eastern Time; subject to change.

1. A cover letter briefly summarizing your project and what you would wish to learn during this session.
2. Your current curriculum vitae.
3. A description of your project (maximum 300 words) including background, objectives, methods, results, interpretation.
