

## CSIM Medical Education Award 2022 Terms of Reference

The CSIM Medical Education Award was established to support, promote, and recognize the IM/GIM medical education activities of CSIM members and associates.

### ELIGIBILITY/CRITERIA

- CSIM Full Members (in good standing) and CSIM Resident Associates are eligible to apply.
- Applicants must be licensed to practice in Canada or be enrolled or accepted in an internal medicine or general internal medicine residency program in Canada.
- Consideration will be given to the applicant's original work involving innovation, leadership and research in the field of medical education.
- The medical education project should be applicable to the practice of IM/GIM within Canada.
- Research or quality improvement projects are eligible if related to medical education.
- Preference will be given to completed projects, although "in-progress" submissions may be submitted.
- The CSIM recognizes all levels of medical education endeavors as important to the specialty of IM/GIM, including undergraduate, postgraduate, and continuing professional development.
- A project may only be submitted once by any one of the project authors. Co-applicants are not accepted.
- Clinical research projects falling outside of the scope of medical education may be eligible under the CSIM Education and Research Fund (please refer to [csim.ca/awards-abstracts](http://csim.ca/awards-abstracts)).

### AWARD

The recipient will:

- Receive a certificate of recognition and a monetary prize of \$500.
- Receive one complimentary registration to attend the CSIM Annual Meeting, October 12-15, 2022 in Victoria, BC (no monetary value if the recipient does not attend the 2022 meeting or if the meeting is held virtually; does not include courses with extra fees or guest registration; travel and accommodation is not included).
- Be announced via the CSIM website, social media, e-newsletter, and/or the CJGIM.
- Receive an invitation to join the CSIM Education Committee.
- Be encouraged to submit their work to the [Canadian Journal of General Internal Medicine](http://Canadian Journal of General Internal Medicine).

### APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The application package must include the following:

1. A letter from the applicant detailing their project (up to 3 pages):
  - Applicant's name, affiliations and contact information
  - Objectives and goals
  - Hypothesis
  - Rationale
  - Methods
  - Timelines
  - Evaluation
  - Outcomes
  - Demonstration of deliverable
  - Next steps / potential scale up
2. A summary of the demonstrated impact on teacher and/or learner (1-2 paragraphs.)
3. An appendix outlining any references, supporting material, websites, multimedia links, etc. (up to 1 page.)
