

THE CSIM OSLER AWARDS 2022

Terms of Reference

Nominations are invited for the Canadian Society of Internal Medicine (CSIM) Osler Awards.

These awards are presented annually to physicians who demonstrate outstanding achievement in the field of general internal medicine in clinical practice, research, medical education, specialty development or health promotion.

ELIGIBILITY/CRITERIA

The nominee must:

- Currently reside and be licensed to practice medicine in Canada.
- Be a CSIM Full Member in good standing (with dues paid).
- Exemplify the best in medicine in the tradition of Sir William Osler.
- Have a sustained record of excellence and innovation in the field of general internal medicine.
- Have contributions over their professional career that clearly sets them apart from their peers.
- Agree to have their name put forward.

AWARD

There will be up to two awards presented annually.

The recipient(s) will:

- Receive a certificate attesting to recognition by their peers and by the CSIM for achievement in the field of general internal medicine.
- Be announced via the CSIM website, social media, e-newsletter, and/or through the [CJGIM](#).
- Receive one complimentary standard registration to attend the CSIM Annual Meeting, October 12-15, 2022 in Victoria, BC (no monetary value if the recipient does not attend the 2022 meeting; does not include courses with extra fees or guest registration; travel and accommodation is not included).

NOMINATION INSTRUCTIONS

The nomination package must include the following:

1. The candidate's curriculum vitae.
2. A letter from the nominator listing the reasons for nomination and emphasizing aspects of accomplishment in the candidate's field as outlined in the above criteria.
3. A letter from the seconder contributing a perspective to the nomination.
