

CSIM Awards for Mentorship 2023 Terms of Reference

The Canadian Society of Internal Medicine (CSIM) is pleased to offer up to two awards per year in recognition of mentorship. These awards are in appreciation of the contributions made by **Dr. Mahesh Raju**, a CSIM Past President and long-time member and supporter of the Society.

ELIGIBILITY: RESIDENT AWARD

One award for a resident in recognition of mentorship of junior resident colleagues.

- This award is intended for residents pursuing a career in the field of Internal Medicine or General Internal Medicine.
- Open to CSIM Resident Associates (R3, R4 or R5 as of the competition deadline) in a GIM or IM residency program in Atlantic Canada.
- Has **not** previously [been a recipient](#) of a CSIM Award for Mentorship. Nominee must agree to have their name put forward.

ELIGIBILITY: PHYSICIAN AWARD

One award for a physician in recognition of mentorship of residents and dedication to internal medicine.

- Open to physicians practicing in Atlantic Canada.
- Consideration will be given to the nominee's work and contributions in fostering collegiality amongst residents, mentoring trainees, and demonstrating leadership in the areas of medical education, research, and/or community outreach.
- Consideration will be given to the nominee's dedication to IM/GIM in Canada.
- Has **not** previously [been a recipient](#) of a CSIM Award for Mentorship. Nominee must agree to have their name put forward.

THE AWARDS

Each recipient will:

- Receive a certificate of recognition and a monetary prize of \$500.
- Receive one complimentary registration to attend the 2023 CSIM Annual Meeting and a travel grant* of up to \$500 to help defray the travel and accommodation costs of attending the CSIM Annual Meeting October 11-14, 2023 in Quebec City, QC (receipts required).
- Be announced via the CSIM website, social media, e-newsletter, and/or through the [CJGIM](#).
- Be invited to join the CSIM Education Committee.

**No monetary value; applicable only to the 2023 Annual Meeting.*

INSTRUCTIONS

The nomination package must include the following:

1. A cover letter from the nominator outlining the mentorship qualities exemplified by the nominee.
2. *For resident nominees only:* a letter from the program director **only if** they are not the nominator.
3. One letter of support from a resident colleague.
4. The nominee's current curriculum vitae.
